
ROUTE J RESERVOIR USE REGULATIONS
Summarized from the City of Monroe City's Ordinance
Effective March 20, 2001

NO OVERNIGHT CAMPING is permitted except for organized groups with official permits issued by the City Administrator and posted at the camp site.

AREA IS CLOSED TO PUBLIC USE from 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. daily unless actively fishing during these times. The gate is closed the day before deer season (gun) and will open March 1st. During the closed season, duck/goose hunters can obtain a special permit at City Hall to use the lake during duck/goose season. Special stipulations apply to those permits.

VEHICLES and boat trailers must not obstruct or block access to roads, parking and boat ramps.

NO OFF ROAD VEHICLES are permitted.

PETS (DOGS AND CATS) MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH at all times.

NO LITTERING is permitted.

NO REMOVAL, TAMPERING, DISTURBING OR DESTRUCTION OF plants or animal habitats.

NO FIRES are permitted except in grills. Fires are not permitted during times of high fire hazard.

HUNTING IS LIMITED to use of shotguns (for waterfowl only) and archery during the specified hunting seasons. No hunting or discharge of firearms is permitted in the public areas, including but not limited to the parking lot, boat ramp, camping areas, and any other place where the general public may be located.

BOATS: Outboard motors greater than ten (10) horsepower may be used, but must be operated at slow, no-wake speeds.

NO SWIMMING or whole body contact with the water is permitted.

FISHING is permitted only with the use of pole or rod. No trout lines, bank lines or jug lines are permitted. No more than three (3) poles or rods may be used by one person.

THE ABOVE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED.
