The Board of Aldermen met in special session at 5:00 p.m.

Mayor Long called the meeting to order.

Mayor Long asked everyone to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Long stated that the purpose of this meeting was to allocate the money received from the Monroe County 36/72 Transportation District. The amount received was \$49,575.70 to be used for roads. Currently, Chester Bross is in town asphalting our streets. While they are here and since we have the money from the 36/72 Transportation District, Kevin O'Bryan has requested that we use that money to pave South Border Street from Highway 24 to West Border Street. Mayor Long stated that the main concern he had was whether or not South Border Street was the next one to be paved and he stated that Mr. O'Bryan advised that it was the next one on the list. It is estimated to cost \$47,000 to pave that street. It was discussed that it is a highly traveled street. Alderman Painter motioned to allocate the Monroe County 36/72 Transportation District funds to paving South Border Street from Highway 24 to West Border Street; Alderman Hays seconded it with Aldermen Painter, Hays and Osbourne in favor and Alderman Viloria opposed; motion carried.

Alderman Viloria stated that he opposed because he felt that the alley off of Mill Street that goes to the south by the Senior Housing complex should be paved. Mayor Long asked that this be noted.

With no additional items on the agenda, Alderman Osbourne motioned to adjourn, Alderman Painted seconded with all in favor. The meeting concluded at 5:05 p.m.
