

CITY OF MONROE CITY REVISED POLICY FOR BRUSH PICK UP

The City of Monroe City picks up brush, tree limbs and grass clippings on the 2nd and 4th Friday of each month during the months of April through November and only on the 4th Friday of each month during the months of December through March. If you have a lot of the above for pick up, you may wish to contact City Hall in advance to advise the Street Department.

- The items must be at the curb by 7:30 a.m. on morning of scheduled pickup.
- Pieces are not to be longer than 10'.
- Only brush is picked up; no wood, fence, tin, etc.
- Leaves and grass clippings will be picked up as long as they are in clear plastic bags.
- If someone is hired to trim a tree, brush, etc., the contractor must remove the trimmings. They may take the brush to the brush pile at the Public Works building.
- Any pieces less than 2' in length should be put in a container or box that can easily be dumped into the truck.
- No brush will be picked up if it is an alley – unless the alley is paved.
- If there is a pile of brush, put the larger pieces on the bottom and the smaller pieces on top.
- Citizens can take brush, leaves and grass trimmings to the City Barn and dump them in the designated area. The leaves and grass trimmings must be removed from the bags.
- Keep brush piles away from poles and water meters.
