

The Board of Aldermen met in special session at 5:00 p.m.

Aldermen Present: Connie Painter, Marvin Vloria, Jeff Botkins, Rusty Rothweiler, Ralph Lemongelli

Alderman Absent: Jason Osbourne

Others Present: Mayor Jerry Potterfield, Jackie Pangborn

Mayor Potterfield called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and asked that all stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor of the City of Monroe City, Missouri to purchase certain real estate from Mo-Go Johnson L.P. was introduced. The proposed ordinance was assigned bill #7.

Bill #7 became ordinance #7-2020.

Two bid specs were received late for the sale of surplus City property. Alderman Rothweiler motioned to reject the bids that were turned in late; Alderman Painter seconded with all in favor.

The items for sale that were not sold will be re-advertised in the Lake Gazette and the Mid-Mo Trader with a revision to the 826 International Tractor and 10' Brush Hog, separating them out the Tractor (\$6,000) and Brush Hog \*(\$2,000). Alderman Rothweiler made a motion to resolicit bids for surplus property with the revision to the price of the 826 International and Brush Hog; Alderman Botkins seconded with all in favor.

There being no additional information to discuss, Alderman Rothweiler motioned to adjourn the meeting and Alderman Painter seconded it with all in favor.
