

The Board of Aldermen met in special session at 6:00 p.m.

Alderman Present: Connie Painter, Marvin Viloría, Jason Osbourne, Jeff Botkins, Rusty Rothweiler, Juben Moss

Mayor Potterfield called the meeting to order.

Mayor Potterfield asked everyone to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Wages and Compensation was discussed. Mayor Potterfield stated that four employees were listed as getting a 20% increase. Alderman Painter made a motion to give a 2% increase across the board, excluding the police. Alderman Viloría seconded with roll call vote as follows:
